- 6. Scholarship grants are paid direct!) to the scholarship recipient. Payment are typically made in the June time frame.
- 7. Scholarship recipient should keep all receipts.
- 8. A social security number is required for our records.
- 9. Mail completed scholarship application to the post office box address above or drop off at the Blount County Memorial Museum.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE APPLICATION

- 1. Applicant must use the official form obtained from the counselor's office or the Blount County Memorial Museum. The form must be dated and signed by the student, counselor and parent or guardian.
- 2. Applications and all supporting documents must be in English.
- 3. Recommendation letters must be originals or photo copies on a single sheet of paper signed by the author.
- 4. SAT and ACT test scores must be included but may be photo copies.
- 5. It is required that exhibits such as awards and media items must be photocopies.
- 6. The application must be arranged in the order described below:
 - *** Application of required facts.
 - *** The applicant must prepare an essay of 250 words or less, typed single spaced on "Patriotism". Include a short paragraph on how this scholarship will help with furthering your education.
 - *** College entrance test scores required (SAT or ACT).
 - *** Currently signed and dated one page letters of recommendation from at least one person, not totaling more than three, in authority from high schools attended by the applicant. Letters may cover applicant's ability, work habits, leadership, personality and integrity.
 - *** Two letters of endorsement from responsible community (non school) persons. These persons should not be related to the applicant. They should be capable of reporting the applicant's participation in the community in terms of work service, leadership, notable skills and outstanding recognition. Each letter should be typed, dated, signed and on one page only.

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- *** Copies of exhibits of achievement in scholarship, leadership, athletics, dramatics, community service or other activities may be attached, but avoid being repetitious.
- *** Application neatness, appearance and your <u>ability to follow</u> <u>directions</u> will be evaluated.
- 7. After completing this application, make a copy for your records. All applications become the property of Operation Grateful Heart Blount County.
- 8. If selected, you will be required to submit a high school photograph of yourself in the last 12 months to be used in the media concerning your achievement.


